

Welcome to Step 1 and Step 2 – "Bilby drawing for children 9 -12 years old.

Materials you will need.

2B or HB lead pencil and an eraser

Tips before you start.

Plan out the size of the Bilby on your Watercolour paper, ensuring you have enough room for the body, head, ears and tail.

Use a light sketch line that is easy to rub out, if you make a mistake.

#1. Sketch a centre line for the body, use your pencil to measure the angle that the body is leaning.

#2. Sketch the simple oval shape of the body.

#3. Sketch a horizontal line for the eyes and nose.

#4. Sketch a circle for the head, the head is quite large in comparison to the body. Then sketch a triangle for the nose (your Bilby may look like a bird at the beginning).

#5. Sketch centre lines for the ears measure using your pencil the length relevant to the head size and angle of the ears.

#6. Look at the angles of the arms, paws, legs and feet, lightly sketch lines for these angles, the Bilby has very long feet make sure to measure the length relevant to the body size you have sketched.

#7. Follow the flow of the tail and sketch a line ensuring it is the right length.
